Parsons State Hospital and Training Center partnered with RWE Clean Energy through its subsidiary, Custom Energy Services, in an effort to generate savings that could be used to address infrastructure improvements such as the replacement of air handlers. The customer also needed help in solving problems with failing steam traps.

RWe Clean Energy's efforts were focused on improving the lighting systems, steam systems, energy management controls, and equipment replacements to improve efficiency. We also improved energy efficiency through replacement of piping systems and old standard flow toilets.
