NOTICE EXTENDING SCHEDULE FOR
SUBMITTING INTERVENOR FUNDING REQUESTS

(Issued February 6, 2018)

On January 8, 2018 the New York State Board on
Electric Generation Siting and the Environment ("Siting Board")
issued a Notice of Availability of Application Stage Intervenor
Funds and Schedule for Submitting Funding Requests ("Notice"),
requiring eligible municipalities intending to request
intervenor funds to submit a Request for Intervenor Funds
("RFIF") by February 7, 2018.

On February 1, 2018, The Zoghlin Group PLLC, Co-
Counsel for the Town of Naples, filed a motion seeking an
extension of time to file a Request for Intervenor Funds. Co-
counsel stated that the extension is necessary in order for the
Town of Naples to review application documents that are fully or
partially redacted and the applicant's response to substantive
comments raised by the Siting Board, Department of Environmental
Conservation and Department of Health. Co-Counsel states that a
request for a confidentiality agreement has been submitted, but
has not yet been received.

Naples' request for additional time to File a Request for
Intervenor Funds, requests will be accepted until April 2, 2018.
